Section J, from the plans of the State Board of Vocational Education submitted to the Federal Board and approved, provides as follows:

"Such instruction shall provide for at least six months supervised practice work, either upon the school farm or through the home project method upon the home farm of the students. In order to conform to these requirements the teacher in agriculture shall be employed for twelve months and it shall be his duty to visit the homes of the students and supervise all home project work."
