

CODE OF CONDUCT

1. I am expected to attend all sessions that are part of the planned program for all activities. I will inform staff if I am not feeling well.
2. I will be courteous clean, and possess good manners.
3. Language must be controlled – no profanity.
4. I will not leave the activity facilities at any time without the permission of the chaperone and/or staff members.
5. I will not smoke or use tobacco products at the FFA workshop.
6. I will not use alcohol, drugs (except those directed by a doctor), or be associated with or remain in the presence of others when they are being used.
7. I will not carry a weapon or threaten another person with a weapon, bodily force, or language.
8. I will respect the rights of privacy of those attending an activity and those with whom I am rooming.
9. I will observe hours established by the staff and be in my room. No boys in girls' room; no girls in boys' rooms.
10. I will avoid unnecessary roughness to room, furnishings, furniture, equipment, etc. Nor, are they to be taken as souvenirs. Occupants of a room are financially responsible for any damage or results of misconduct.
11. Any participant at an official FFA Workshop activity who observes a breach of the code of conduct has the responsibility and obligation to report the misbehavior to the appropriate chaperones.
